There will be free admission to all Marinette County Parks, day use areas, and boat landings on Saturday June 6 and Sunday June 7.

Wisconsin residents can fish without purchasing a fishing license on June 6 and 7 as part of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources free fishing weekend.

All other regulations remain in place.

All camping fees still apply at all Marinette County Campgrounds.

Grab your tackle box, take the family, and get outside for some fresh air. Enjoy the time with your family make some lasting memories, and put worries behind you.

Marinette County Facilities & Parks Department operates 11 large developed parks, 6 small day use parks, and 7 boat landings. Marinette operates and maintains some of the most beautiful spots in Wisconsin. Check out Marinette County Parks at Dave's Falls, 12 Foot Falls, Veteran's Memorial, Goodman, McClintock, Twin Bridge, Morgan and Twin Bridge.

Keep the fun going all summer long by visiting our beautiful parks with a \$5.00 daily entrance fee, that is payable at our park entrances. Otherwise, plan ahead and get a \$20.00 annual sticker. Your annual sticker can be purchased from the Facilities & Parks Department office located on the third floor of the Marinette County Courthouse at 1926 Hall Avenue, Marinette, WI. Stickers can also be purchased from the Land Information Office, located on the first floor of the Courthouse. Stickers can also be purchased from multiple vendors throughout Marinette County.
